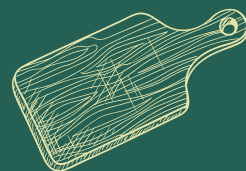

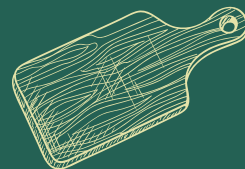

Market Site Fees

If successful in your application, you will receive an email approximately 2 weeks prior to the next market. This email will ask if you will like to attend and any location preferences.

Stall positions are then assigned based on your requirements, 1 - 2 days before market day. This email will also include your stall number and a site plan.

On market day, the Market Manager (in a green vest) will be available to help you find your site. Vehicles must unload and leave the market area by 8:45am and cannot return for loading until after 1pm.

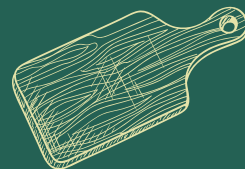
